## **2016 Summary Results for Key Stage 2 – SATs**

The 2016 Key Stage 2 assessment system is very different to the assessment used up to 2015. A revised, more challenging curriculum for primary pupils was introduced in 2014. The new tests and assessments reflect the changes to the curriculum.

Because of the changes to the curriculum and assessment system, results for 2016 cannot be compared with results for previous years.

Previously results were reported in levels, the key benchmark being the percentage of children who achieved level 4 or higher in reading, writing and mathematics.

New tests results are reported as a scaled score for **reading, grammar punctuation and spelling**, and **mathematics**. The scaled score runs from 80 to 120, with 100 as the expected standard. **Writing** is assessed through teacher assessment so is reported as the number or percentage achieving the expected standard according to the current assessment framework.

Results are reported in percentages.
