Art Self Portraits

This unit will allow the children to learn about portraits, and use different materials and techniques to produce their own. Children will explore using colour and shape to create a collage inspired by artists in this unit. The children will have the opportunity to explore the work of Pablo Picasso, Paul Klee, Henri Matisse and Andy Warhol and create artwork inspired by them.

To use a range of materials creatively to design and make products.

To use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination.

To develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space.

To know about the work of a range of artists such as Henri Matisse, describing the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines, and making links to their own work.

Food Technology Healthy Eating – Fruit Salad

To develop understanding of food groups and healthy eating.

To develop skills such as cutting fruit, preparing food and using utensils safely.

RE Creation and Christmas Story

The creation story:

Music Exploring Genres of Music Charanga/Jolly Music Schemes

To use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.

To play tuned and untuned instruments musically.

P.E. Schemes: Real PE & iMoves Dance Balance, Agility and Coordination

To master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities

To participate in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending

To perform dances using simple movement patterns.

Dance:

Healthy Me: To enjoy creating and performing short dance sequences to music using turn, travel, jump, gesture and levels.

Toys: To be able to perform simple moves and build them up to a dance.
